Hi everyone. Attached to this email is the first spreadsheet of the Moosehaven Centennial Project and it contains the donations that have been received and recorded by MOOSE CHARITIES since 1-30-2015 through 7-13-2016. How To Read Spreadsheet: The "A" Column contains Lodge District Assignment and is only used for the LOOM. Column B Contains the Fraternal Unit's or Individual's name. Column C is the FRU identification number.

Column D is the date of the check sent to Moose Charities. Columns F through P are for Committee use to keep track of the Award levels and if they have been issued. Column Q is the total amount of donations received by Moose Charities for that line. Column R In addition to being the dateline for the span of donation dates it is used for notes and odd dollar amounts. The reason the sheets are printed sideways on the 8.5x11 paper is due to a computer glitch, no ready solution and need to get information to you in a timely manner. WRITING The Check: Date the check. On the payee or to line write MOOSE CHARITIES. Fill out remainder of check. ON CHECK FOR /MEMO LINE put CSEA MHN Cent. Prog. If you do not do this your donation will not be credited to OUR ASSOCIATION'S account or to YOUR FRATERNAL UNIT.

MAILING The Check: Mail check to MOOSE CHARITIES 155 S. INTERNATIONAL DRIVE; MOOSEHEART IL. 60539-1100.

THE PROGRAM: This CNMA fundraising project is in response to an International Moose program to raise \$10,000,000.00 in a three (3) year period and donate it through MOOSE CHARITIES for the specific purpose of building a new 305 unit of a 1 and 2 bedroom Apartments on our MOOSEHEART SENIORS HOME site in an effort to provide for our current and future Residents. At the CNMA Midyear Conference the Association Board voted to make a minimum commitment of \$150,000.00 toward the Project which comes to \$1005 per each Fraternal Unit within the California/ Nevada Association. The Special Projects Committee put together a program that set up a three year program with a minimum donation level of \$335.00 per CNMA FRU along with a multiple step AWARDS program that provides recognition for attaining the minimum donation levels and well above those minimum levels. The LEVEL AWARDS are available to all Fraternal Units functioning within the Association area as long as the donations are made in the CNMA MHN Cent. Prog.name. In order to prevent misunderstanding the CMNA FRU's are made up of the Lodges Districts and Council of Higher Degree's areas. The Women of the Moose and Moose Legion Jurisdictions are internationally controlled groups and have minimum expectations separate from the Association's, however we have always invited them to participate in our AWARDS recognition program and they have always responded in a positive manner. We thank them for their ongoing support of our Committee and the Association.
