

Please make your room reservations as soon as possible. Please remember after **August 11**, **2024**, all unsold rooms will be released to the public and sold at the hotel's higher rate. If for some reason you cannot attend and need to cancel your room after the deadline, please contact Convention Liaison Dina Munday, as others may need the room. As always, we encourage all to **pre-register and purchase your meals in advance**. Attendance and advanced meal selections help keep our costs down. We can only keep our prices lower by meeting our room blocks and meals requirements.

Everyone knows that with the increased costs we are all experiencing, supply chain shortages, and other issues prevent us from providing specific menus for each meal.

Attached is a manual registration form that is only to be used for those making reservations by **CHECK**. *No debit or credit card reservations will be accepted by mail.*

Additional reminders:

District Presidents will only be reimbursed for hotel expenses incurred at the Nugget
Casino Resort. In other words, if you stay at another hotel you will <u>NOT</u> be reimbursed
out of your district's convention expense account. <u>NOTE</u>: Sufficient funds must be
available in the district convention expense account held by the California Nevada Moose
Association (CNMA) and only if remitted by the District Secretary <u>prior</u> to the

- convention in order for <u>anv</u> District President to be reimbursed. As provided in the CNMA District Guidance, District President expenses must be voted upon and approved <u>prior</u> to the Convention and documented in the District meeting minutes.
- 2. All <u>current</u> District Presidents are expected to attend this convention. Alternates are <u>not</u> allowed for District Presidents.
- 3. All incoming District Presidents are expected to attend this convention and to be present at the Banquet on Saturday September 14th which includes purchasing a ticket for the banquet.
- 4. All Lodges **must** to be represented by the President and Administrator.
 - a. Alternates must be designated in writing as provided in the CNMA Policy Manual. All Delegate letters <u>MUST</u> be received <u>two (2) weeks</u> prior to convention <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!!</u> <u>The deadline is August 30th, 2024</u>.
 - b. Guidance on delegates can be found on the CNMA website under *Secretary* > *CNMA Documents* > <u>Alternate Delegate Guidance</u>. Please read this guidance and adhere to the instructions and sample provided in order to ensure the alternate delegate is recognized at the convention.
- 5. There will be a March of Checks on Saturday September 14th. Please ensure that each check is properly addressed and earmarked.
 - a. Checks for the CNMA President's Project are made payable to Moose Charities and are earmarked CNMA President's Project.
 - b. Checks for the Moosehaven AAA Project are made payable to Moose Charities and are earmarked Moosehaven AAA.
 - c. Checks for the CNMA Disaster Relief Fund are made payable to the California Nevada Moose Association and earmarked Disaster Relief Fund.
 - d. Checks for Youth Awareness are made payable to the California Nevada Moose Association and earmarked Youth Awareness.
 - e. Checks for Endowment are made payable to Moose Charities and are earmarked Endowment Fund.
 - f. WOTM Checks for the Golden Gavel Convocation are <u>NOT</u> to be included in the March of Checks. These checks should be brought to the Golden Gavel Convocation held on Sunday September 15th or given to the Convention Services Team Registration Desk.
